



PAVILION RENTAL & USE RULES

- Rental is limited to ROSRC members only who are in good standing and 21 years of age (minimum) with 14 days advance notice.
- All pavilion rental requests require submitting a completed "Pavilion Use Reservation Request" form and \$50 payment to ROSRC. Reservations are first come, first served so payment must be received to secure the date (email or form alone is not adequate to hold a reservation).
- Pavilion is only available to rent for one AM and one PM event daily (unless blocked out for a club event) and are limited to a maximum of four (4) hours per event. AM events must be completed by 2pm. PM events can start as early as 3pm, and must be completed one hour prior to pool closing time.
- Reserving member must be present for the entire pavilion use time and ensure that all attendees follow ROSRC pavilion and pool rules.
- Every effort must be made to minimize disruption to the neighbors bordering the pool. Any Board Member shall have the right to discontinue any party or special event that he or she deems too disruptive to neighbors or is in violation of rules.
- Guest fees for non-member attendees are an additional \$3 fee for EACH person (whether swimming or not). Daily guest wristbands will be provided by the Pavilion representative. At the conclusion of the event, member must submit payment for non-members and return any unused wristbands.
- The maximum number of guests (both members and non-members) allowed is 40.
- Additional lifeguards must be secured from Sweetwater Pools for swimming attendees using the separate Sweetwater request form located on their website <https://www.sweetwaterpools.net/pool-parties/pool-party-request-form-hoa/> :
1-25 guests: 1 lifeguard required 26-40 guests: 2 lifeguards required
- ***ALL reservations are contingent on securing required lifeguards.***
If reserving member is unable to secure lifeguards by 48 hours prior to event, it will be cancelled, and \$50 fee returned. If the number of swimming attendees exceeds the number of lifeguards secured, party may be discontinued by pool designee or any board member.
- Absolutely NO GLASS is allowed anywhere in the pavilion/pool area. All food, drinks, decorations, etc. must be in non-glass (plastic, paper, aluminum, etc.).
- At the end of rental time, all non-member guests must leave and exit the premises without returning.
- Reserving member is required to complete a thorough clean-up after the event (reference separate Clean Up Checklist). Failure to properly clean will result in an additional \$25 charge.
